The program features comprehensive lectures and hands-on instruction covering key aspects of family law trial practice, including ethics, witness preparation, and direct and cross-examination techniques.

Participants will observe and engage in a mock temporary orders hearing before sitting family law judges. Before the trial college, attendees will prepare direct and cross-examinations based on a provided fact pattern. During the program, participants will prepare their client, present their case, and receive individualized feedback in small group settings led by family law judges and Fellows of the American Academy of Matrimonial Lawyers (AAML).
